

# Brunswick News - Nanos Research poll nailed popular vote totals

An exclusive Brunswick News and Nanos Research poll entering the final weekend of the New Brunswick election campaign ended up mirroring the actual popular vote.

The survey suggested that the Gallant Liberals had the support of 37.4 per cent of decided voters just days before the election. Support for the Progressive Conservatives was second at 30.2 per cent.

Meanwhile, the poll pegged the People's Alliance in third with 12 per cent, and within the margin of error of the Greens, at 10.8 per cent. The New Democrats were predicted at 9.6 per cent.

That was nearly identical to the outcomes for most parties.

The Liberals ended up with 37.8 per cent of the popular vote, the Tories 31.9 per cent, People's Alliance 12.6 per cent, Greens 11.9 per cent and New Democrats five per cent.
